This project is dealing with the existing gaps in the field of unemployment in Georgia, through improving quality of employment services in the fields of job placement and career counseling for unemployed and job seekers. It is also improving skills development and competences of unemployed disadvantaged groups by implementing a new model of intensive coaching and providing key competences training for “hard to employ” individuals throughout the country.

This project is part of EU's Skills4Jobs programme and overall efforts for economic development.

By significantly enhancing the quality of SESA's digital & analogue service provision the Project will (1) make relevant skills-matching services more accessible and effective in Georgia as whole, especially career- guidance, counselling and job intermediation.
