Project description:

The project is part of EU's EU4Justice programme. It supports justice system reforms through monitoring, evidence-based advocacy and dialogue with individual judges. The project also increases involvement of community groups in the reform process of the judiciary through awareness-raising and mobilization. The project:

- Monitors implementation of the 'Third Wave' of the justice reform as well as the chief strategies and actions plans, including the Judiciary Strategy and Action Plan;
- Promotes communication and dialogue with individual judges and judicial bodies; through discussions about the role of individual judges in the judiciary;
- Promotes range of participatory processes, supports formation of public opinion and mobilizes activist groups.

Expected results:

- Shadow reports are prepared that objectively assess the results of passed reforms and puts new directions of the reform on the agenda
