Project description:

The programme will support national and regional readiness to identify and respond to drug-related security and health threats.

Expected results:

Networking and partnership are central to EU4MD. The project will deploy a participatory approach to capacity building ('learning by doing') and activities will focus on developing practical and scientific knowledge, along with the skills of professionals and organisations. On the supply side, EU4MD will support a better understanding of drug markets; capacity development for forensic analysis; assessment of the environmental impact of drug production; identification of 'hot spots'; mapping of production and trafficking dynamics; technological innovations; threat assessment and responses to emerging issues.

On the demand side, work will focus on identifying trends in prevalence and patterns of drug use; drug-related harms; supporting treatment, harm-reduction and prevention activities; dissemination of innovative monitoring approaches; development of gender-appropriate responses; and assessment and promotion of services for vulnerable populations.
